Changes to the parish:

Last September Fr Slavic was appointed as assistant priest to our parishes for one year. The Derby Deanery of Priests and Parish Councils have discussed the situation to look at what we need to have in place for when Fr Slavic leaves. Currently we have 4 Masses at the weekend. With just one priest available, this will be reduced to 3 Masses over the weekend, with changes being put into place on 8th/9th October. The times of Sunday morning Masses will remain the same at St Hugh's and St Alban's. Evening mass on a Saturday will move to 5pm either at St Alban's or The Church on Oakwood. There will be no Sunday 5pm Mass. The Parish Council will talk to us about the changes at all Masses at St Alban's and The Church on Oakwood on the weekend of 10th/11th September, inviting us to offer our opinions on the proposal. Thank you for your support in this difficult and sensitive time of change.
