

DERBY DEANERY (1st/2nd April 2017)

The Bishop and Bishop's Council have approved a programme of reorganisation and rationalisation of the parishes of the Derby Deanery.

The following parishes will be clustered together:

St Mary's, Derby, Holy Family, Allestree, and Christ the King, Mackworth; Masses of Sunday in this cluster will be reduced from 7 to 5 and the number of clergy from 3 to 2.

St Alban's, Chaddesden, St Hugh's, Borrowash, and English Martyrs', Alvaston; Masses of Sunday will be reduced from 7 to 5 and the number of clergy from 3 to 2.

St George's, Normanton, St Joseph's, Derby, and Our Lady of Lourdes, Mickleover; Masses of Sunday will be reduced from 11 to 7, and the number of clergy from 5 to 3.

St Joseph's, Burton, Holy Rosary, Stapenhill, and St Peter & St Paul, Swadlincote; Masses of Sunday to be reduced from 4 to 3 and 1 priest.

In addition, services at Holy Rosary will be discontinued, and this cluster will be transferred to Loughborough Deanery.

These arrangements will take place by the beginning of September this year.
