### School News:

Saint Benedict School would like to congratulate their A level and GCSE students on their record breaking results this year. The A Level students achieved a 100% pass rate and 55% of all A level grades were A\*, A or B. 27% of all grades were A\* or A. We have students travelling as far as Falmouth and Aberdeen following a wide range of degree courses. It's also been a record-breaking year for their GCSE results. The school's Attainment 8 score, which measures the attainment across the best 8 subjects of all pupils, has risen from 4.29 in 2017 to 4.81 in 2018. The percentage of pupils achieving a grade 4 or above in English and maths (equivalent to the old grade C) has improved from 62.3% last year to 65.7% this year. Over 80% of all pupils achieved a 4 or above in English and 62% achieved a 5 or above in English and maths has also improved from 31.6% last year to 37.5% this year. A total of 57 grade 9s were achieved by pupils this year compared to 11 last year. Headteacher Mr Gritton offered his congratulations to the students and thanks them and staff for their hard work and support.

Please remember in your prayers our young people who have received, or are waiting for, exam results: that in the midst of their celebrations or disappointment they understand that their worth does not depend on academic success. We wish them all well as they face the new academic year, and other exciting challenges ahead of them.
