Research Request

If I may very briefly introduce myself; I am a member of the local community and a (very) mature, part-time PhD student undertaking an ethics and law degree at De Montfort University, Leicester, looking at the potential options at the very end-of-life for those terminally ill patients for whom (and I appreciate it will be a very small number of individuals) that pain and anxiety cannot be eased through traditional palliative care techniques. My research aims to build upon the viewpoints of legal professionals in this area, palliative care specialists and also, critically, those in our society who have in the past, (which I must stress; previously not currently) cared for and lost loved ones, friends and family. It is in regard specifically to this final group that I would be very grateful if you would consider noting and raising the profile of my research with members of the Parish and St. Hugh's.
