Mass Intentions and Sanctuary Lamps

The tradition of offering Masses for others, originates in the very early Church. An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person or family (such as a birthday, anniversary or to thank a special person), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Mass Intention envelopes are available from the church foyers and should be returned to the parish office or handed to Fr David or Deacon Juan Carlos. We are fortunate to have more Mass intentions than we have Masses so there is usually a wait before Mass is celebrated. We always try to accommodate requests for specific dates, however weekends especially, are popular. Would you be happy to share your Mass date with another parishioner – please indicate this on the Mass Intention Envelope. Mass Cards are also available from church, these can be signed by Fr David and given to whomever the Mass request has been made for. You may prefer to sponsor a Sanctuary Lamp for a week for £3, again for any intention or loved one. Thank you for your continued generosity.
