Those who think they commit no grievous sins against God's law can fall into a state of dull lethargy. Since they see nothing serious to reproach themselves with, they fail to realize that their spiritual life has gradually turned lukewarm. They end up weakened and corrupted." Reflect: Have you ever experienced a season of spiritual lethargy? How can the Sacraments and prayer help you more awaken in your faith?
