This was the enforced famine of Ukraine between 1932-1933 in which it is estimated that over 7 million citizens perished. Derby City Council has officially recognised the Holodomor as an Act of Genocide against the Ukrainian people and Ukrainian nation. On **Saturday 23rd November**. The unveiling of a memorial plaque dedicated to the victims of the Holodomor at the Sir Peter Hilton Memorial Gardens (adjacent to the Derby Quad Arts Cinema) at 1.30 pm with a Panakhyda Service (memorial Mass) & a small exhibition, to raise awareness, will be available to view outside the Quad Cinema entrance on the 2nd floor from 19-23 Nov.
