EU Settlement Scheme

The United Kingdom is due to leave the European Union on 31st October 2019, with or without an agreement governing this departure and the ongoing future relationship between the UK & the EU. The Catholic Church in England and Wales stands in solidarity with all EU citizens who have made their home here, many of whom are an integral and valued part of our parishes, schools and communities, including here in the Diocese of Nottingham. The Church has experienced first-hand the extensive contribution that people from across Europe have made to our society and recognises the evidence that immigration from the rest of Europe, and from further afield, has not undermined opportunities for British citizens, but rather has brought considerable economic and social benefits. However, the law concerning the free movement of people will be changing as a result of decisions taken since the referendum on the UK's membership of the EU, and EU, EEA & Swiss citizens must apply to the settlement scheme if they are to protect their existing rights and place in our society. British citizens & Irish citizens do not need to apply. There is no fee for applying to this scheme - it is free of charge. Derby Catholic Refugee Support

Barbara Stirrup from Derby CaReS will speak in Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Centre on Wednesday 18th September at 7.30pm. As you may know, the Derby Deanery is the first in the Nottingham Diocese to be working towards helping a Syrian refugee family settle in the city. The inspiration for this came from Pope Francis' words in 2015: "I make an appeal to parishes, religious communities, monasteries and shrines throughout Europe, that they express the Gospel in a concrete way and host a refugee family." In the last decade, conflicts across the Middle East and North African region have left millions of people in need of protection. Local authorities and community and faith groups across the UK are helping refugees to feel welcome and able to adjust to a new life in the UK through the government's Community Sponsorship scheme. Please do come and hear about the background to the scheme, some experiences of families who have settled in the UK and about ways you might be able to help. We look forward to welcoming you on the night."

St Ralph Sherwin Catholic Multi Academy Trust (MAT) In September 2018 the MAT was launched, bringing together 25 schools, 20 primary and 5 secondary. It is one of four Trusts in the Diocese of Nottingham supporting the Bishop's vision to secure and develop Catholic education in the Diocese for our current children and those who will follow them in future. With around 8000 children and 1200 staff, the Trust covers a wide geographical area from Glossop in the north to Swadlincote in the South, Marple Bridge in the west and Eastwood to the east. We are extremely blessed by the dedication and support given to our schools by hundreds of volunteers who bring their talents to bear for the benefit of our children. Some volunteer to read with children, others to help develop practical skills such as sewing or gardening and we have over 150 people who volunteer their time as school governors.
