Ways to support you & others in Lockdown II

Helping to keep each other connected with the parish (St Alban's, St Hugh's & The Church on Oakwood) is really important. Here's how:

- A. **Collecting a Newsletter** from the box outside of the Halls at St Hugh's or St Alban's or...
- B. **Join in the Phone Tree:** let us know if you or a relative would like to receive a phone call catch-up but do get their permission first or...
- C. **Newsletter Delivery:** let us know if you or a fellow parishioner would like a Newsletter posted through their door by our Team or...
- D. If you have an unwanted tablet or laptop & you could **set-up someone in your support bubble with the internet** so they can watch the live streamed Mass via www.derbycatholiclive.co.uk or...
- E. **Burn onto a DVD a copy of our Sunday Mass** from our Derby Catholic Live website and here's how:

- Step 1: Order a pack of blank DVD-R's that you can record the Mass onto (aka burning a disc) e.g. a pack of 25 Verbatim DVD-R Discs is £5.85 on Amazon.
- Step 2: Download the Sunday Mass ISO Image File via the 'Video Resources' tab at www.derbycatholiclive.co.uk. It'll be in a black box marked with the date of the most recent Mass at the top & will download as a Zip File (approx. 4 mins), open the Zip File & then the folder with the Mass, then drag the ISO File (which looks like a washing machine) onto your desktop.
- Step 3: You may already have DVD burning software but if not, I used the free software ImgBurn whereby once downloaded you:
- i. Click on the top left option of 'Write image file to disc'
 - ii. Near the top click the yellow file in 'Source'
 - iii. Select the Sunday Mass ISO Image File (on your desktop)
 - iv. Insert a blank DVD-R
 - v. When the bottom image of the ISO blue arrow to disc is coloured, click on it
 - vi. Finally click the 'Eject Tray' box towards the top & you'll hear music in around 5 minutes when the disc is burned.
