Pope Francis New Letter

Fratelli tutti is the title Pope Francis has chosen for his encyclical letter dedicated to "human fraternity" and "social friendship". In English, it can be read as 'Brothers and sisters all'. The first words of the new 'circular letter', or encyclical as we know it, come from St Francis of Assisi, whose name Pope Francis chose when he was elected, & said "Let us all consider the Good Shepherd who, to save His sheep, bore the suffering of the Cross." Booking for a Weekend Mass

1. The booking window is Sunday 1pm to Friday 11pm, please phone or text EITHER **St Alban's Booking Line: 07517439084** & leave a message with your choice of the 6.30pm Saturday at Oakwood or 10.30am Sunday Mass at St Alban's OR **St Hugh's Booking Line: 07935609769** for the 9am St Hugh's Sunday Mass. For both churches then leave your name, phone number, the number of places you require & your priority code A, B or C:
 - A. Parishioners who are not on the internet & those living alone.
 - B. Families of Stewards or those helping at Mass that weekend + those who didn't get a place last weekend.
 - C. All other Parishioners.
2. You will receive a message Fri/Sat to either confirm your booking or, if your Mass is full, to offer you a place at another Mass or to say that all are full.
3. When you arrive at Mass, a Steward will guide you to your place.
4. If you arrive at Mass without a booking, you will only be invited in if there are free places & a Steward will record your details.
