## **Derby Refugee Project Update**

Our application for approval has gone to the Home Office. We had to reapply due to the long gap between our initial approval and the scheme resuming as things reopen. We hope this will only take 2-3 weeks, after which we anticipate a house being identified. This house must be approved by various agencies and then a family will be identified I for us. It could take up to 10 weeks for a family to arrive. All still a while away but at least things are moving. When we're a bit closer we'll let you know further details. It is guite possible that a family coming Ito Derby will not be Syrian at this stage with so many countries in turmoil at present so we could be welcoming people from almost anywhere but, of course, still via the Home Office & official channels. St Hugh's are funding the furnishing of a Bedroom & St Alban's Parish & School are equipping the Kitchen. I
