For both churches then leave your name, phone number, the number of places you require & your priority code A, B or C:
 - A. Parishioners who are not on the internet & those living alone.
 - B. Families of Stewards or those helping at Mass that weekend + those who didn't get a place last weekend.
 - C. All other Parishioners.
2. You will receive a message by 4pm on the Saturday to either confirm your booking or, if your Mass is full, to offer you a place at another Mass or to say that all are full.
3. On arrival, a Steward will guide you to your place.
4. If you arrive at Mass without a booking, you will only be invited in if there are free places & a Steward will record your details.
