

The booking window is from Sunday 1pm to Friday 11pm for the forthcoming weekend Masses, please phone or text EITHER St Alban's Booking Line: 07517439084 & leave a message with your choice of the 6.30pm Saturday or 10.30am Sunday Mass OR St Hugh's Booking Line: 07935609769 for the 9am St Hugh's Sunday Mass.

For both churches then leave your name, phone number, the number of places you require & your priority code A, B or C:

- **A.** Parishioners who are not on the internet & those living alone.
- **B.** Families of Stewards or those helping at Mass that weekend + those who didn't get a place last weekend.
- **C.** All other Parishioners.
- 2. You will receive a message by 4pm on the Saturday to either confirm your booking or, if your Mass is full, to offer you a place at another Mass or to say that all are full.
- 3. On arrival, a Steward will guide you to your place.
- 4. If you arrive at Mass without a booking, you will only be invited in if there are free places & a Steward will record your details.
