Holy Week this Year

As we welcome you to join our Holy Week liturgies, Masses and services, please remember that they are online only this year, with just have a skeleton liturgical team supporting our celebrations, and those being received or Baptised at the Easter Vigil. Please join us for **THE SACRED TRIDUUM** starting with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday to the Easter Vigil at 7.30pm Friday with Easter Sunday Mass at 10.00am. This is considered the most solemn part of the liturgical year. This three-day period is referred to as the *Easter Triduum*, also known as the *Sacred Triduum*, or *Paschal Triduum*. The word "triduum" comes from the Latin word *triduum*, which comes from *tris* ("three") + *dies* ("day"). The Sacred Triduum is a festival recounting the last three days of Jesus' life on earth, the events of his Passion and Resurrection, when the Lamb of God laid down his life in atonement for our sins.
