## Friends of Chaddesden Wood Litter Pick

All are welcome to join a Litter Pick around Oakwood as part of the Great British Spring Clean 2021. It will run from **10.00 to 12.00 noon on Saturday 12 June**. Meet at Springwood Drive gate from 10am for a safety briefing and to collect litter pickers and bags (all sanitised and disinfected). You choose to walk or drive to an area you would like to clean, or fan out from the meeting point. Your full bags and pickers should be returned by 12 noon, so that Derby City Council Parks Department can take away all the rubbish. If you wish to separate the rubbish as you go along, just take two bags, using one for recyclables and the other for general rubbish. At last year's litter pick volunteers collected over 40 sacks of rubbish and made a real difference to our neighbourhood.

For both churches then leave your name, phone number, the number of places you require & your priority code A, B or C:
  - Parishioners who are not on the internet & those living alone.
  - Families of Stewards or those helping at Mass that weekend + those who didn't get a place last weekend.
  - All other Parishioners.
- You will receive a message by 4pm on the Saturday to either confirm your booking or, if your Mass is full, to offer you a place at another Mass or to say that all are full.
- On arrival, a Steward will guide you to your place.
- If you arrive at Mass without a booking, you will only be invited in if there are free places & a Steward will record your details.
