He also served for many years on the Derbyshire County Cricket Supporters Club committee, regularly stewarding coach trips to away venues.

He worked on a number of player benefit committees, but it was as the club's main scorecard seller that he will be best-remembered. For almost two decades, Peter would walk around the ground selling scorecards and yearbooks, always cheerful whatever the weather.
