

Baptisms:

Congratulations to Joshua John Hodgkinson who will be baptized at St Alban's Church on Sunday 14th August at 12 noon. Our prayers and best wishes for Michelle and David, his Mum and Dad, on this very happy occasion. Well done everyone!

The New Translation of the Mass:

'Lord I am not worthy'.

As the Priest invites us to receive Holy Communion, he will say, 'Behold', rather than 'This is' the Lamb of God. 'Behold' means 'to look at' and it is our invitation to adore Christ who we are about to receive in Holy Communion. We are used to saying 'Lord I am not worthy to receive you...' This will change to 'Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed'. This is almost exactly what the Roman Centurion said when he came and begged Jesus to heal his servant. When Jesus says he will come to the Centurion's house, the man knows that Jesus doesn't need to do that; just his word will be enough. The Centurion says; 'Lord I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word and my servant will be healed'. Our new reply changes only one word of the Centurion's speech – 'my servant' becomes 'my soul' will be healed.

Living Ministry Course:

The course is for all adults interested in exploring their faith, and those involved in areas of ministry such as teaching, catechists, Eucharistic ministers, parish council members, youth work, etc.

The course provides the opportunity to explore and reflect on questions of faith and belief and every-day living as members of the catholic community today. 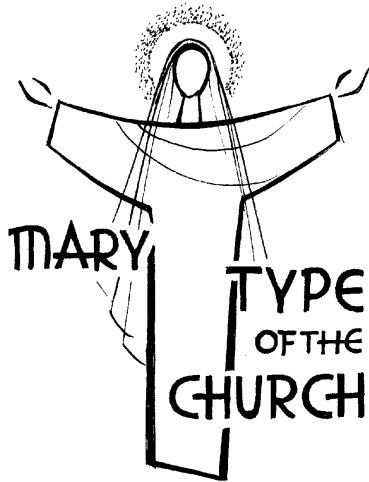
