The New Translation of the Mass:

One of the first things we will notice with the new translation is that when the priest says; 'The Lord be with you' we will say 'And with your spirit'. This is much closer to the original Latin. When the Mass was first translated into English we were one of only two languages that did not translate it as 'your spirit'. It is a very biblical response. St Paul concludes four of his letters with a very similar expression. For example, at the end of his second letter to Timothy, Paul ends by saying; "The Lord be with your spirit. Grace be with you". Join us for the last of our evening sessions when we will be celebrating Mass in the new translation at St. Hugh's on **Thursday 21st July at 7pm**. Stay for a glass of wine afterwards and please bring something for a shared table if you can.
