The New Translation of the Mass:

We will notice some changes in the Gloria and the Creed in the new translation. In fact, there isn't a great deal of change in the new words that we will pray, so we will have to be careful that we don't slip into the old text! The first lines of the Gloria itself echo the angels' message to the shepherds announcing the birth of Jesus. Because of these changes, new music will be written so that we will be able to sing the new translation too. When it comes to the Creed, we will notice the first change immediately – "I believe", not "We believe". We have become used to praying the Creed all together as a parish. The trouble is, when we say "We believe" it could suggest that between us all we believe everything being said. It is not clear that we all believe everything that is being said. To say "I believe" makes it quite clear that each one of us believes everything we are saying individually.

Living Ministry Course:

The course is for all adults interested in exploring their faith, and those involved in areas of ministry such as teaching, catechists, Eucharistic ministers, parish council members, youth work, etc.

The course provides the opportunity to explore and reflect on questions of faith and belief and every-day living as members of the catholic community today. Marriage: Couples wishing to marry are required to give at least six months notice. See Father Paul.

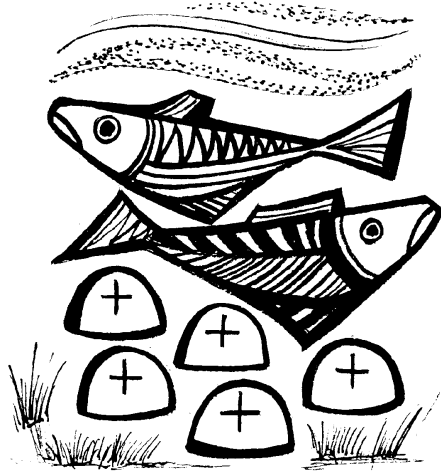
