

For those who have died:

We remember in our prayers the happy repose of the souls of Ladislav Gabco and Dan Wickes who have died recently. May they rest in peace. The New Translation of the Mass:

The Second Vatican Council reminded us of our ancient faith; that Christ is always present in his church, especially in its liturgical celebrations. So each time we come to Mass we experience the presence of Jesus in four different ways: i) His presence in the congregation – the people gathered together, ii) His presence in the Priest, iii) His presence in the Scriptures that we listen to during Mass, iv) His presence in the bread and wine when it becomes the Body and Blood of Christ. The more we are able to understand and join in the Mass, the more we will come to love it. The new translation will help us do that because the words we will now use will say more clearly what our faith is teaching us.

Join us for our remaining two evening sessions when we will look at the new translation of the mass. Each session will last about 45 minutes. The third of our four sessions will be at St. Alban's on 7th July and session four on 21st July at St Hugh's.

Sea Sunday (10th July):

Next Sunday (10th July) is Sea Sunday, when the Church remembers all those who live and work at sea. It is our chance to help The Apostleship of the Sea (AoS), an agency that offers pastoral and practical support and care for those at sea and their families. 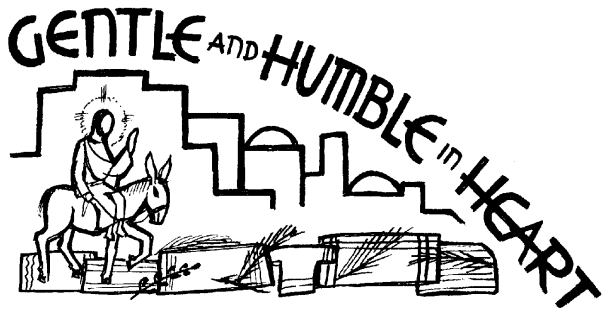
