The Briars Open Day:

First Holy Communion:

Next Sunday (19th June) 24 children will be celebrating their 1st Holy Communion in the parish. The celebration will take place at the 10am parish Mass, with an extra Mass scheduled for 2pm. Please keep the children and their families in your prayers at this happy time.

The New Translation of the Mass:

Until the early 1960's, Mass was celebrated in Latin throughout the world. At the 2nd Vatican Council, it was agreed that Mass should be celebrated in the language of the country in which it was being celebrated. There was no change to the Mass itself, just the language being used was different. This would help us to understand more fully what was being said and to participate more fully. An English translation was made available as quickly as possible, but it was intended to be temporary. A more considered translation would be issued later. Now, some 40 years has since passed! This translation has at last been agreed by Rome and we will begin using it in our parishes this September.

There will be 4 evening sessions in which we will look at the new translation of the mass. We will be sharing the sessions with St Hugh's Borrowash. Fr Paul and Fr Ka Fai will lead the sessions with each session lasting about 45 minutes. If you are interested in knowing more about the translation, looking at the texts that will be used and why the new translation is taking place, come along. The sessions will take place on Thursday evenings at 7pm and the dates are: 23rd June at St Alban's, 30th June at St Hugh's, 14th July at St Alban's and 21st July at St Hugh's.

Added Responsibility:

Fr Paul has been appointed as 'Episcopal Vicar for Laity' in the Diocese by Bishop Malcolm, and has been asked to be a part of the Bishop's Council – a College of Consultors to assist the Bishop. This will obviously mean added responsibility around the Diocese, and therefore more work outside his parish duties. Please keep Fr Paul in your prayers as he begins his new role.

Reflecting on the Scriptures:

Join us this Monday (13th June) at 7.30pm in the church. We will be reflecting on the Gospel reading for The Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity. It's an easy, relaxed 45 minutes for quiet prayer, reflection and sharing thoughts.

Service of Anointing and Healing:

There will be a special service of anointing at St Alban's Church on Saturday 25th June at 12 noon followed by a light lunch in the Parish Centre. If you would like to come, invitations are available at church, to be returned by this weekend for catering purposes.

Remembrance Frame:

Every month in a special remembrance frame, the names of deceased members of our parish family and friends will be displayed so that we can keep them in our prayers. We are compiling the list from our parish register which includes the names of those whose funerals have been celebrated from St Alban's. If you know of any members of your family or friends who may not be in our register for deaths, please let us know their name and anniversary of death so that they can be added to this special list.

Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist:

A reminder to our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist that on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (25th/26th June) you are asked to make a renewal of your promises in front of the community - to pay due reverence at all times to the Eucharist when ministering to others. You will have the opportunity to make that renewal at any of the Masses on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi.
