The New Translation of the Mass:

Until the early 1960s, Mass was celebrated in Latin throughout the world. At the 2nd Vatican Council it was agreed that the mass could be celebrated in our own language, and in 1970 Pope Paul VI agreed the official Latin text that would be used. This was then translated into different languages throughout the world. It proved to be a huge task which was completed in a very short time. However, because it was done so quickly, some of the richness of the original Latin prayers was quite literally 'lost in translation'. It was seen that a further translation was needed. The new translation would keep the original words, meaning and style of the Latin as far as possible. Our evening sessions will look at the new translation of the mass. We will be sharing the sessions with St Hugh's Borrowash. Each session will last about 45 minutes. The second of our four sessions will be at St Hugh's on 30th June. Session three will be on 7th July at St Alban's and session four on 21st July at St Hugh's.
