Assisted Dying Bill – Urgent Appeal to Oppose Doctor-Assisted Suicide:

Please write to your MP today, asking them to oppose the Assisted Dying Bill. There will be a vote in the House of Commons on 11th September 2015. It is urgent to write to MPs before 21st July as this is the last day before the summer recess. After 21st July, many MPs will be away from the House of Commons until September. This Bill would allow doctors or other health professionals to provide help such as lethal drugs for dying people to commit suicide. If passed, this Bill would place vulnerable people at serious risk.
