

St Alban's Parish Council Nominations & Elections:

Are you interested in serving on the Pastoral Parish Council (PPC)? Every three years, a new PPC is elected and this a great opportunity to be involved in the administration and development of St Albans and The Church on Oakwood, as well as providing valuable support to the parish priests. A formal announcement of the process will take place at masses on the weekend of 16/17th April and the nomination forms will be available from these dates - the deadline for nominations will be 8th May. In the meantime, if you have any questions about being involved, please ask one of the PPC members.

Procession in Honour of Ven Mary Potter:

Bishop Patrick will lead a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to remember the Venerable Mary Potter, who worked in Nottingham in the 19th century caring for the poor, destitute and dying, and who is buried in St Barnabas' Cathedral. Beginning at 2.30pm, this Sunday (10th April), from St Mary's Church, Goodliffe Street, Hyson Green, to process along Alfreton Road and Derby Road before reaching the Cathedral at 5.00pm, when Bishop Patrick will give Benediction. The purpose of the procession is for Christians to walk together and raise awareness of the work of Mary Potter, to celebrate the life of a very important local person, and to pray for her to be recognized as a saint. All are welcome to this walk of witness, at which many different groups will be represented including local Catholic parishes and chaplaincies, the Indian Catholic community, the African Catholic community, the Little Company of Mary.

DBS disclosures for those at St Hugh's:

The Diocese now requires everyone in ministry with children and vulnerable adults to renew their DBS (formerly CRB) disclosure if their existing disclosure form was issued pre June 2012.

The DBS check can now be done online, so as a first step, Margaret Burns will need to have email addresses if possible of those who need to renew their DBS.
